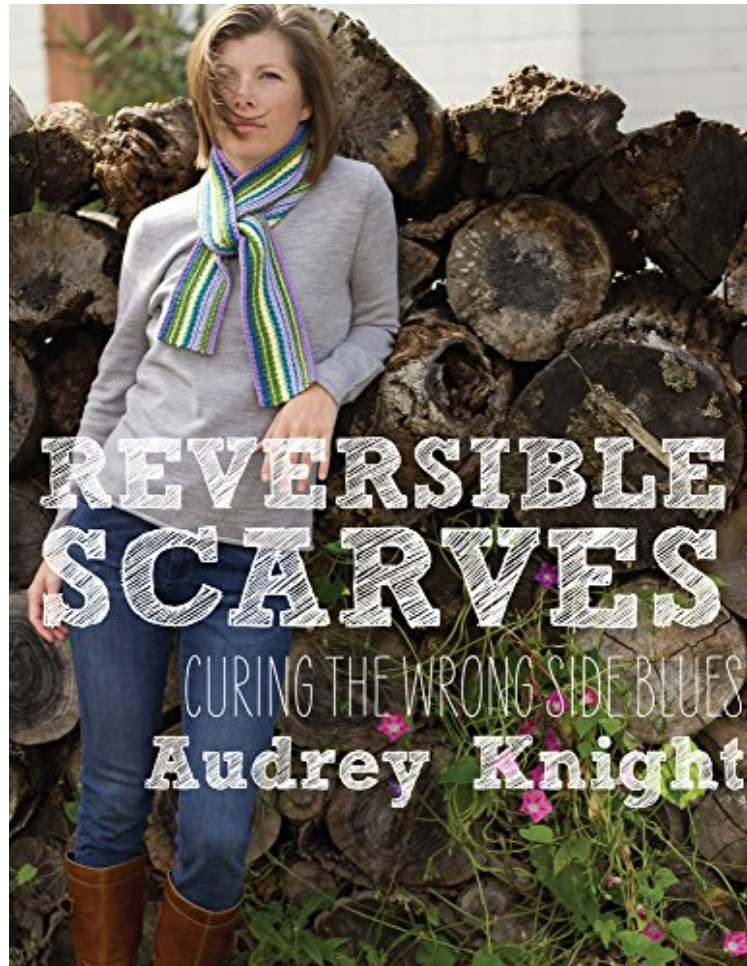

With more than 30 patterns and variations of the reversible scarf, this book offers a solution for the knitter that enjoys crafting scarves but is dismayed when the wrong side shows. The patterns range from simple to detailed using a wide variety of techniques to suit different skill levels or to match the mood of the knitter. Even the more complex looking patterns are deceptively simple, such as the double knitting designs that use simple knit, purl, and slip stitches. Sidebars are included that give hints about how a pattern can be modified to give the knitter more creative freedom. Scarf knitters will turn to this book again and again for inspiration and will always find just the right design to fit the taste of their friends or family.

My personal favorite feature of the book is Audrey's thoughts, insights and inspiration on her own design process. These little gems, tucked throughout the book, help the reader understand her process. And at least in my case, allowed me to see the genius she used to develop some of her designs."
