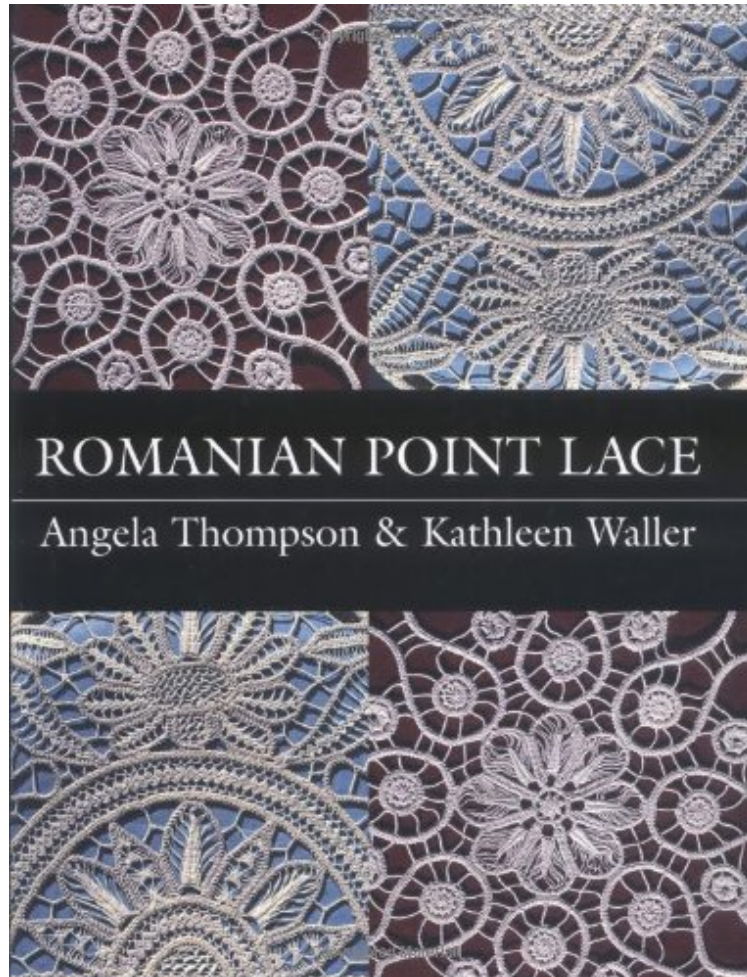



## Romanian Point Lace
