A few of the projects are useless as far as I am concerned, especially the pillows and the tie shrug but there a number of interesting projects and some fair isle patterns that I am going to try out. There are large and small knitted projects which is nice since I am always looking for ways to use my leftover yarns. It would have been nice to see less sweaters in shades of gray but that is just a minor point. Projects include a cable wrap cardigan, a seed stitch jacket, a simple felted child's cardigan, a delicate and feminine lacy wrapover top, and a shrug. Accessories with Scottish flair include Fair Isle socks, gloves, scarves, and some great knits for the home, such as a Fair Isle throw blanket with Fair Isle stripe, Fair Isle chunky cushions, and a patchwork blanket.
