I also made the City Tote that is featured on the cover using the pattern included. This is the first bag I've ever made and I have to say it turned out better than it thought! As a beginner, I did have a little trouble understanding Whelan's directions. I had to redo my darts after I'd sewn all the way around the bag (simply because I've never done darts
