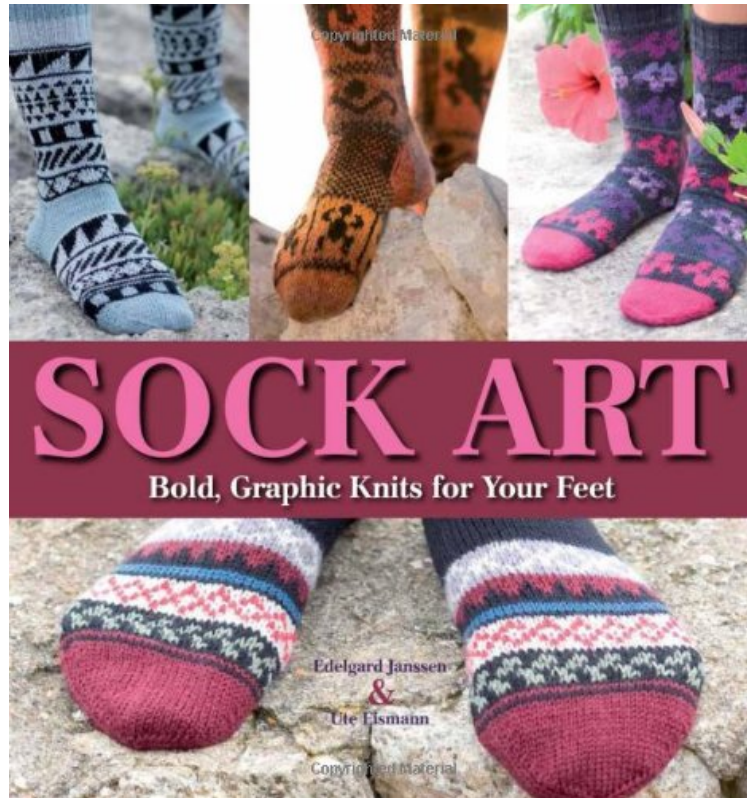

There is a section on animal motifs - fish, cats,ethno look. There is a section on different types of stars and there is on on geometric shapes.The book goes over basic techniques for sock knitting but is really a book for those who have experience already with knitting socks.The patterns are nice and interesting, most in a Fair Isle style.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. When I decided to get this book it was because of my love for colour stranding and fair isle techniques. The patterns in the book were much better than those in many other books I saw. I believe I could actually knit several of the patterns in the book (If I knew how!) This book offers zero help for beginners or intermediate knitters (I've already knitted a plain sock and I'm quite good with fair isle so I think of myself as high-intermediate at the designs in the book and a beginner at the construction). The instructions of each pair of socks come with a particular sizing and I

am not sure how to change that to fit me (as shown on pages 18/20 of the look inside preview) If the instructions are for a women's small, how do I go about fixing that to make a pair in the same design but for a women's medium? I still like the book very much because I know I'm getting there with knitting socks and most of the patterns are really great and just what I was looking for.
