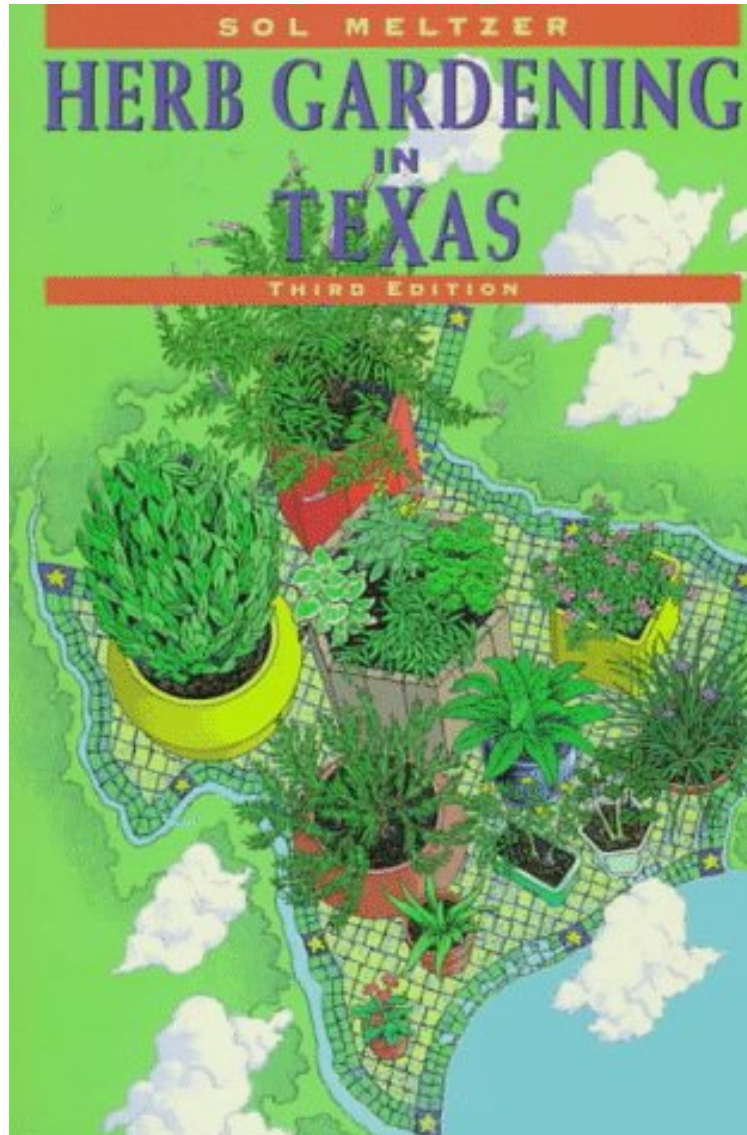

The fact this book is for herb gardening in Texas caught my attention right away. I have been steadily expanding my herb garden for the past 2 years. The information on the herbs themselves is in the second half of this book. The first half

has recipes, planting suggestions, propagation suggestions, and brief information (a few pages) on dyes, bath oils, medicinal qualities of the herbs. The author lists the majority of the more commonly used herbs in detail. I do wish this section was bigger. As an herbalist, I enjoy finding books with in-depth information on the growing and collecting of herbs. As well as books about preparations for various medicinal remedies. I personally use this in conjunction with my Culpeper's Complete Herbal, The Herb Book by John Lust, Edible Wild Plants by Oliver Perry Medsger, The Vegetable Gardener's Bible, and The Illustrated Encyclopedia of Herbs (UK based content).-----For Beginners, this book is a wonderful must have. It can teach you a lot about planting herbs and propagation for those of us who live in Texas. Most of your other herb books while good are from a more northern climate point of view, where it doesn't get hotter than dickens with little to null rain for the majority of spring/summer.
