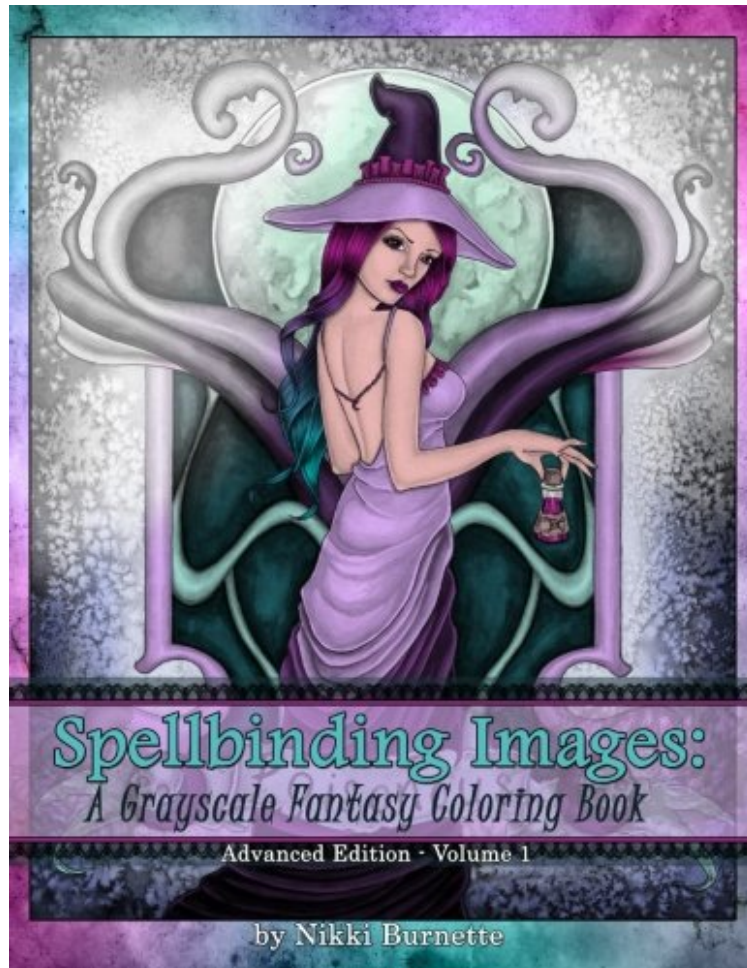

the adult coloring book interest. Nikki has done two new and unusual things with her Spellbinding Images in Grayscale. First of all creating a Beginners Edition (the green cover copy) AND an Advanced Edition resulted in an educational set of books. Immediately I saw the learning potential in having a copy of both. I rushed them both through 's '1 click purchase'. I'm a beginner colorist so this was a no brainer and no regrets purchase for me. When my sister saw Nikki's Spellbinding Images in Grayscale she made the same purchase. Nikki's second innovative idea was to include copies of her colored test images for each page in the book plus she gave us two of each to test out our own color schemes. Never have seen this before but hope that this inclusion in Nikki's Spellbinding Images attracts other artists to do so as well. These two new ideas are very exciting, innovating and absolutely genius. Way to go Nikki. You took a risk and it is going to pay off for you. I hope other artists will follow your example. Mythros0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Well designed coloring book By reader It is clear that a lot of thought went into designing this book and it shows, clearly. There are not only the details of each image, including the black border (so we can be a little sloppy at the edges and not show), the smaller replicates of each image so you can try out different color scheme, to the tutorial in the beginning and the choice of paper itself (feels luxurious and smooth). This is the book (and Nikki's very helpful Youtube tutorials) that taught me how to color grayscale and made the experience fun. I have had another grayscale coloring book prior to the purchase of this one, the results uploaded by other reviewers are nothing short of impressive, but it was rather daunting to even attempt to color them. After a couple of failed attempts, I looked up Youtube tutorials and came across Nikki's channel and the rest is history. I do prefer the advanced version, not because I'm great at coloring grayscale, but I prefer to use the grayscale as guides, and not having to use as much color to cover up the darker grays. I think it also opens up more color choices as well. I've attached my rather incomplete and clumsy first attempt.
