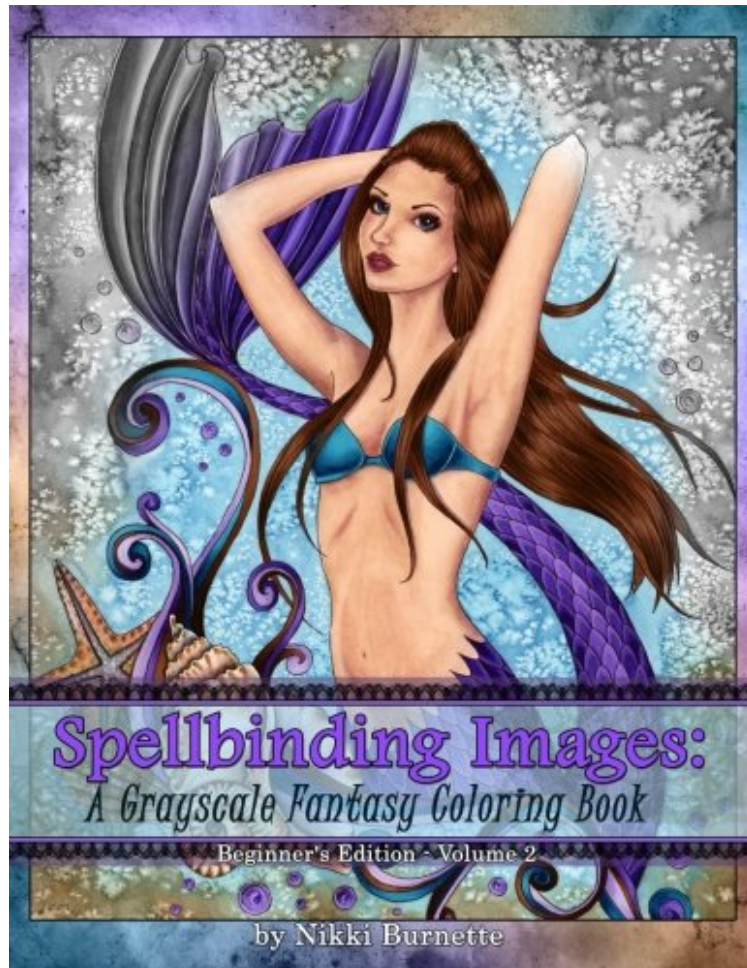

Dark areas are too saturated with blackBy IMHOI am a beginner to grayscale and for me, this book had too much saturation of black in what should have been the "dark" areas of the grayscale. The paper has very little tooth so anyone will be able to color the pages. Alcohol markers blend through the paper even though the paper is rather heavy. They paper did take eye make-up used for some of the backgrounds, however, use a fixative to get it to stay on the page. Personally this was not my favorite gray scale book but you only

The images are done in grayscale, which basically means the shading is already there for you in the image. The paper is very high quality, making the book suitable for both colored pencils and markers. The first few pages provide the reader with instructions for using the book, but there is still plenty of room for creativity by the colorist. Also included are test images so the colorist can try out different color schemes. The images themselves are stunning high quality.
