Bought this book for a single pattern By KAinNCI bought this book for the Egyptian Shawl pattern, which is not available for individual purchase. I consider myself an intermediate+ knitter, having completed multiple sweaters and shawls using lace patterns and cables. On first sight, this pattern's layout had me confused. It would have helped to know at what point in the shawl I was beginning to knit. After copying the pages and blocking out the parts that did not apply to the version I was making, I simply followed the instructions "blindly" until it became apparent where I was in the construction of the shawl. I'm pleased with the finished result despite the mental calisthenics and purchase of an entire book to make it. 10 of 11 people found the

I love the Thick and Thin Wrap. Its red hued colorway is just beautiful. The Always The Right Time Striped Shawl would be an every day staple for someone who lived in a cold climate. I want to knit the Triangle Lace Shawl. It speaks to me in its red lacy pattern and it does not look too difficult to knit. The Spiral Cowl in its yellow and white colorway is lovely. The Two-Color Sideways Garter Shawl is unique and definitely in my 'to knit in the future' pile. The Egyptian scarf is bright and beautiful in turquoise, red, green and purple. There are many other patterns in this book and there is something for everyone who likes to knit shawls and scarfs. I highly recommend this book.
