The *Stitch-Opedia* by Helen Winthorpe Kendrick is an extremely thorough reference guide. It features various types of embroidery with a brief history on each; tips on technique and design; a 12 page Listing of Stitches including thumbnail-sized color photos of each stitch; 30 projects with full page photos and thorough instructions; and finally a few pages of gallery photos; a glossary and an index. It's spiral bound and will endure as a reference book in my collection for many years. Although this book is copyrighted in 2009, it looked a little dated to me and some of the projects (ie kingfishers, chinese fruit, cathedrals, and ducklings) are not the direction I am taking my embroidery. No one can describe the intricate steps of making proper stitches better than Mary Thomas's *Dictionary of Embroidery Stitches* published in 1935, but as a way to cross-reference, I would feel good about recommending this book to other fiberistas. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
