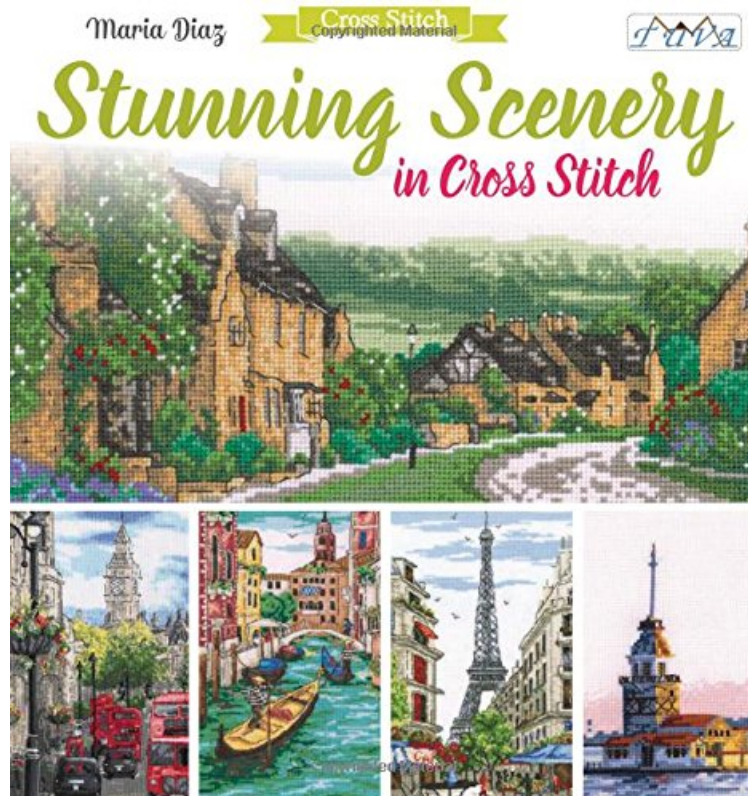

The designs are scenes from around the world, with a good deal of attention to to important religious cities and landmarks. Mecca, Medina and Jerusalem each has its own pattern. Things I love: 1. The table of contents displays a picture of each design, along with the name and page number vs. just the name and page number. 2.Each design is introduced with a short but interesting write-up about the site. Things I don't love so much: 1) The patterns are in color, whereas I prefer black and white (apparently, that places me firmly in the minority). 2) The book has fairly small dimensions, which causes the patterns to be broken up across several pages. The designs themselves, however, are awesome! The Mecca pattern is done in a sort of sepia tone look, which is absolutely amazing, and the Jerusalem design is also quite impressive.
