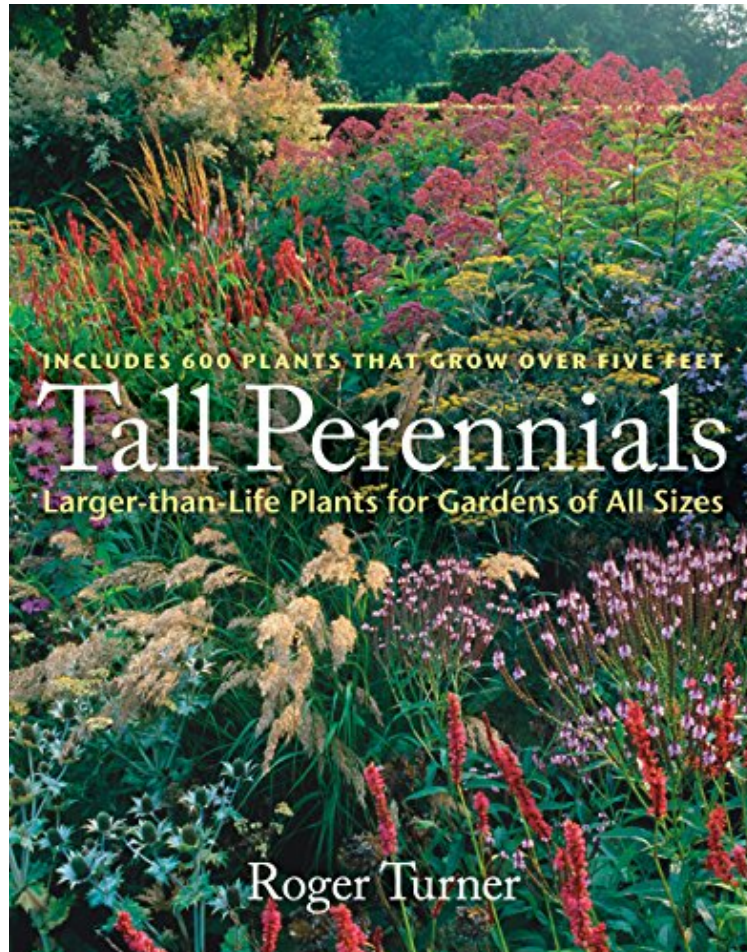

I have slight doubts of the photo depicted as miscanthus s. 'Kaskade' on page 119 is in fact a miscanthus! I was hoping that a good detail of the genus aconitum would be delivered in these pages; whilst it mentions numerous forms and species, a good detail of these choice tall perennials are lacking in our reading literature. We rely on Graham Rice's 'Encyclopedia of Perennials' to give us the best reference, at the present time. The gardener looking to add tall perennials to his borders

will find this book ideal for the purpose. A timely book.
