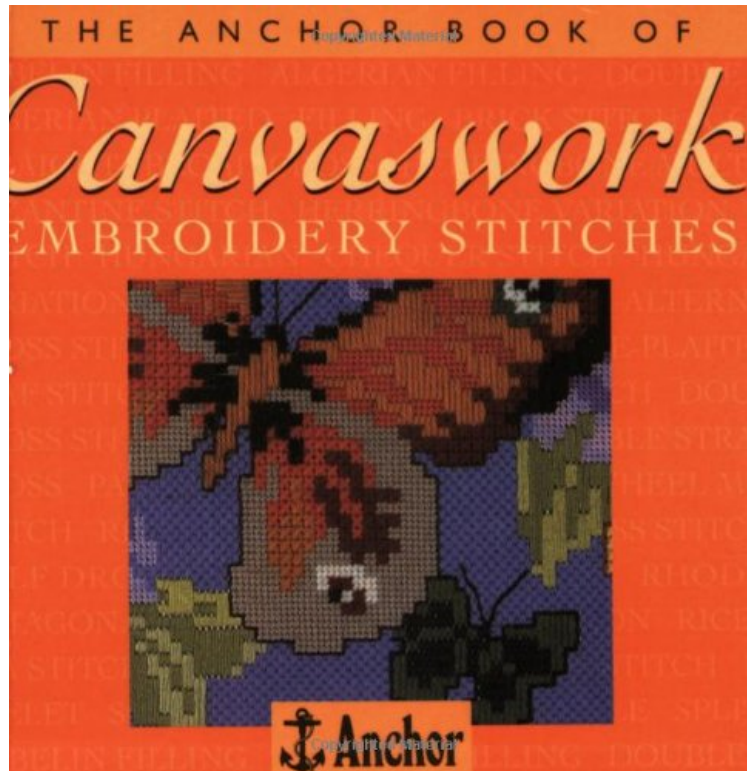

Please don't be put off by the cover By Jane in Milwaukee When I first glanced at the cover, I thought it looked like Eeyore from Winnie the Pooh looking downward. Oops...maybe it's like a Rorschach test or something. Nevertheless, it's not an inspiring cover...you can't really make out any individual stitches and I don't think it's very attractive. But look at the Look Inside feature and see the colorful house: while the house is also sort of Mickey Mouse (mixing up my animation here...), if you look at the stitch illustrations below it, you see they're pretty clear. Canvaswork is enjoying a boom of designing now. Many people think all surface work like this is needlepoint but it's not: canvaswork tends to use more types of stitches and is often more geometric, whereas needlepoint often more for stitching pictures. For the prices offered here right now, this book is a bargain. It's amazing how many textures you can achieve with only 48 simple stitches. Each stitch appears in alphabetical order so you can quickly locate the one you need. Color photos showcase completed products, as well as detailed close-ups. You also get 25 pages of working charts for many of the designs. Stitches include Algerian Plaited, Byzantine, nine forms of Cross Stitch, Florentine, Herringbone, Jacquard, Pinwheel Milanese, Satin, Scottish, and 31 more. 128 pages (all in color), 6 x 5 3/4.
