And if you haven't gone beyond some basic LEGO kits yet, maybe this will encourage you to try your hand at 'free-style'. This is not a "how to" book (the section on that in the back is fairly basic). I especially like trucks and airplanes, and the modelers in this book have skillfully recreated the proportions and dimensions of the vehicles in LEGO form. My only complaint is that the book is shorter and smaller than I had expected. The subjects go from trains to cars, trucks and military aircraft. It is a well bound book too, and I like that it's hard cover. One final note- there are absolutely no directions in this book, so don't expect any. It would be unreasonable to expect that, as the parts count is enormous.
