As a memorial book, it is definitely hagiographic but nevertheless a good general biography of President McKinley. His experiences during the Civil War and during his career as a Congressman could usefully have been covered in more detail. Numerous addresses of McKinley are published in whole or in part. The anarchist movement of his time is provided with a good summarization. Particularly of interest as a reflection of the times are the memorial addresses and messages about the assassinated President by notable personages of the day.

This book is definitely worth consulting if interested in McKinley.
