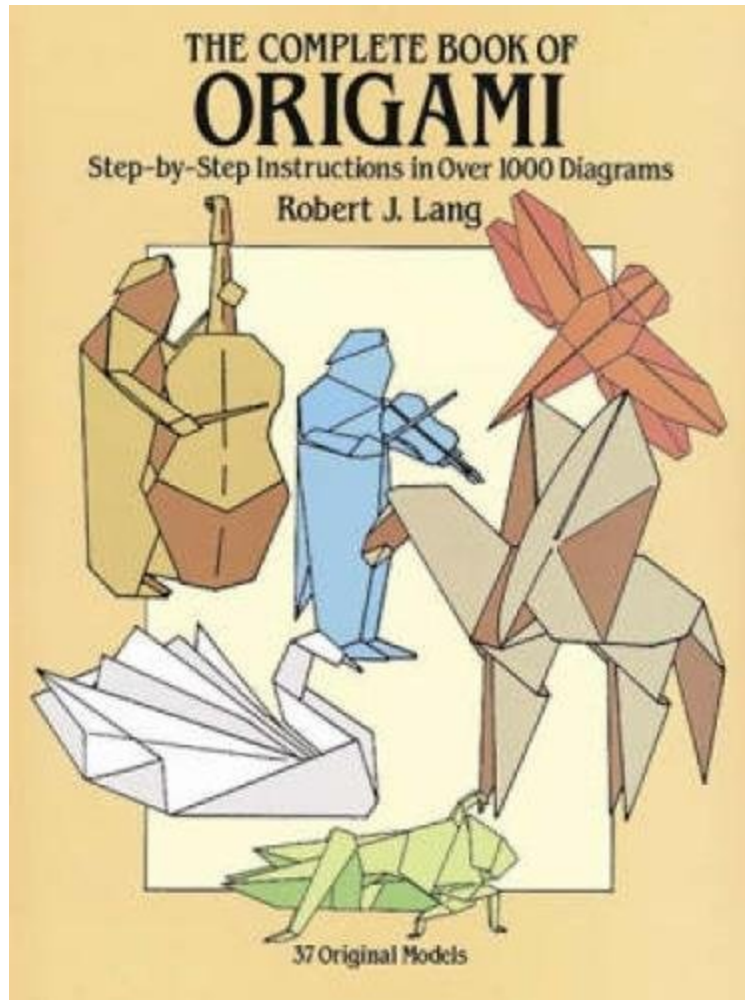

My paper is in a small box, and I fold on a lap desk. The finished products can be decor for a while, or can be passed on as small gifts or ornaments. The patterns in the book start simple (white-faced mouse) and work up. Directions are clear and the diagrams display well on the Kindle. Altogether, this book gives great value for space and money.
